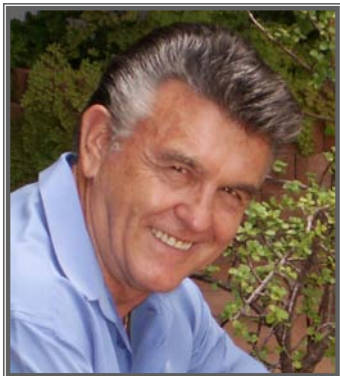

## Ross Speaks on.... Create a New Focus

When taking a seminar in Melbourne in the mid 2000's, I was asked by a therapist to see a client who was having a severe problem with his ankle. His history showed he had been a long distance runner who had broken his ankle and had it plated a few months earlier. He said the ankle had improved but he was in constant pain and was unable to pursue his passion for running. The final medical outcome was to fuse his ankle. He was told this would help the pain but would not allow him to run again. He made the decision to have the operation and was to

see the surgeon two weeks following our meeting.

I treated him on a table for about 15 minutes, after which I asked him to sit up and then stand up for me. He placed both feet together on the floor and began to walk around. At first he went well, then slowly began to limp. I listened to his words as he began to talk himself back into pain. I stated I could notice where the problem was and asked him to get back on the table. I made some simple moves, asked him to sit back up and stated he should be fine now. I then asked to look at his wrist and asked if he had much trouble with the wrist. He said 'No, why?'. I suggested he should keep a watch on it just in case it started painning but I believed the ankle would be fine.

He returned to the therapist for a follow-up appointment a week later. He told her he had cancelled the surgery as his ankle had improved dramatically. He had decided to keep his appointment to have his possible offending wrist checked. She did a light treatment on his ankle and the last I had heard his quality of life had improved and he had gone back to running.

What I had done was to give him a new point of focus with the potential of pain. This caution was less invasive on his health and allowed him to pursue his passion.

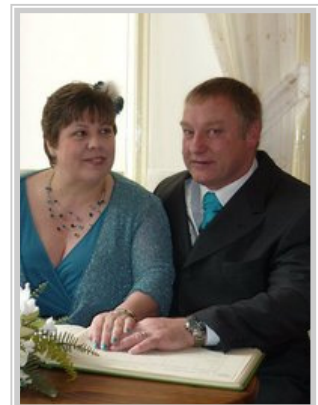

As I write this, she is leaving for Brisbane for a hearing implant in one ear. This is an opportunity no one believed would ever happen. She has had hearing return to her other ear and a vision improvement as well. After her last medical check, many were shocked at the nerve regrowth in her ears and her progress. We laughed as Lee reminded me she had once said "Stick with me and I will make you famous". She is certainly one gutsy lady. Her results from her trip to Brisbane will be known on the 21/01/11 and we will inform you of her continual progress. Best wishes Lee from all of us.

The second is the invitation of Emmett therapist, Debbie Keighran, to work with a major state transport company in treating staff and working towards injury reduction. Debbie has only been using Emmett and the outcome has been fantastic. Her treatment outcomes were recorded and tabled over a 3 then 6 month period and the results showed a dramatic improvement in the lost time injury rate. The company was so impressed that they have contracted therapists in other state workshops to perform the same treatments. The conditions being they are to only perform Emmett and the treatments are to be based on the EP1 training days. Therefore, the treating therapist will need to state that they are using Emmett only when treating the workshop staff, thereby creating referrals for Emmett only treatments. This puts the future of Emmett Therapists in a very special place. We will keep you updated and a personal big thanks to Deb.

We had a small class of students in these towns except for Cloncurry where we cancelled the course. Instead we met the local councillor and staff at the council chambers and looked for contacts and venues for future reference. They were enthusiastic but pointed out the Cloncurry show had just finished the day before. The whole town looked like it had a BIG night out. It took 20 minutes to get 3 coffees and there were only 4 of us in the shop. We left with the local events calendar and plenty of ideas for our return later in the year.



There was a recurring theme during the courses in Mt Isa and Hughenden. The distances people need to travel and the lack of follow-up services made us aware we have to teach the moves as easily, down to earth and user friendly as possible. Everyone has to feel confident to use the techniques when we are not there to supervise.

EmmChat newsletters were handed out at the end of each course with the statement of attendance to introduce everyone to the Emmett community they are now part of.

### BACK IN TOWNSVILLE

We took stock of the successes and shortcomings and started to put together a kit for future courses/trips. We also talked of the resilience and character of the people we had met and how much impact this had on us personally. All of us agreed about the need for a follow up around twice a year.

# Emmett Technique and Arthritis

## A Study on the effectiveness of Emmett Technique on Arthritis

Lake Cathie Therapist, Bob March, is currently working with members of his local Arthritis Association to determine the effectiveness of the Emmett Technique on 'long-term' and severe suffers of Arthritis.



When we spoke with Bob he said that although he is not ready to write anything up as yet (he has a relatively small group participating in the study), they have reported such remarkable results so far that everyone was stoked. He hopes to have something written for the next issue of EmmChat. Bob said he initially received 5 participants in the study, and straight away discovered a bit of a problem with a couple of them wanting to own' their disease.

He has continued with 3 participants who have suffered from severe Arthritis for an average of 20 years. They have had 2 or 3 treatments, they now feel fantastic and can't believe the changes after such short a period. He said he gives them a general treatment with Emmett ... then finishes with the Emmett Lymphatic drainage from Module 6. He feels this creates the greatest improvement.

They cannot believe the impact of this simple/un-invasive treatment. The next day they can really feel the difference with 'the flushing of the system...'. He also went on to explain changes in urine etc. Bob did mention that he has asked them to make small dietary changes... no wheat, start the day with a fresh vegetable juice, increase their water intake and reduce all sugars.

He has been receiving phone calls from others associated with the Arthritis Assoc who are interested in the results and is having constant 'blogging' type conversations with some of the ladies involved. Thanks for the details Bob, we are looking forward to hearing more about your progress.

Most of us have met Karen MacKenzie over the years, either as the sure hands and welcoming smile supporting Ross during our module training, or as the owner/therapist of her own highly successful clinic 'Body Alignment Centre' in Townsville. *Wanting to back up the technical side of therapy and training with the added power of the spoken word, I completed my NLP qualification. This proved to be another exciting part of the journey. Today my life is divided between a busy clinic (where I am blessed with the therapists I work with), helping with Emmett Technique and Emm-Tech courses, travelling with Ross and having time with our families. The most precious gift I have been given is the opportunity to share what has been shown to me to help people with pain and to be part of the growth of others. # Emmett hits the Mines....

Anyone who has trained with Ross will know he first established himself in the Mining Town of Mt Isa. It was while working as Maintenance Crew at Mt Isa mines, he was first exposed to alternate therapies and commenced his interest in massage and remedial therapy. So imagine his delight when Emmett Tutor and Therapist Gail Illingsworth commenced work as a contractor to treat miners on-site at Century Mine MMG - Lawn Hill.



Gail was invited into the mines Well-Being Program, with District Nurse Bernie Murphy, to work with the Mines staff as part of the Program. Under the program the company employs professionals to supply the mine staff with treatments and services. The individuals then make a small payment (around \$20) which is donated to a charity – currently The Flying Doctors & Prostate Cancer.

They work on the basis of 12 hour shifts, in which time Gail performs 30 minute treatments, achieving between 9 to 11 people in a session. Then Gail, Bernie and Personal Trainer Rae Robertson (who are both EmmTech graduates) tour the camp sites to communicate the availability of the Well-Being program. This opportunity enables Gail to provide the staff with an Emmett experience based on Ross's Principal of up-to 7 moves – which has become the basis for the Emmett WorkSafe program being trialled by another organisation.

Gail and the team see a huge variety of clients from supervisors and administration staff, through to truck drivers, operators and, of course, the miners themselves. The results to-date have been great with some good experiences for staff receiving neck, shoulder, forearm and even knee releases. With the interest in the technique mounting, Gail has suggested to them that there is an opportunity to conduct EmmTech training on site. Gail writes..

*“We have been doing well out at the mines, with good feed back with to “Up to 7 moves” which I was able to use this trip as we went onsite, mainly for the office people. I have been using releases on Neck, Shoulder and Forearm and receiving good feedback. They asked what I was doing and I said it was Emmett Therapy which was developed by Ross Emmett himself, a Mt Isa Man for 30 years. I also promoted EMM-Tech for self help first-aid and they asked Bernie if I was running courses there at the mine for this First-Aid Muscle course, as they seemed interested. Unfortunately, not at the moment. Regards Gail.”*

## Testimonial: Sometimes clients become our students

A regular client of mine suddenly went into an extreme back spasm whilst at home. It was so severe that she rang me for an emergency session. When I saw her she was white with pain and could hardly move. The pain came in waves which reminded me of contractions, and she had to shallow pant to get through them. 15 minutes into the session she was more comfortable, with the sharpness and severity greatly reduced, but she was still with some pain and restriction. I sent her on her way wishing that I could have helped her more.

Later that day she sent me an email saying how much better she was feeling. A week later she returned in a much better state than previously but still not 100%. She was curious to know why her body did what it did. I knew there was a big psoas involvement and I asked her if she had been doing any activity that was one sided. I showed her with the straight leg raise the difference between the two sides and both of us could feel that the left side was greatly restricted. I asked her what had she done to put stress on the left side of her body. She spent some time thinking back and then told me the story. She was pruning some high roses and her 3 year old grandson wanted to help, so she lifted him up onto her left hip and held him whilst she continued to prune. Together with me having cleared and balanced the psoas, and her having clarity about the cause of the spasms, she completely relaxed into a beautiful balanced state. I received an email from her the next day and it simply said: "I am as free as a bird." Result!

# Update from the UK

Emmett Technique hits Ireland! Last week, Sue Gassick and Debbie Kinley travelled to Ireland to put on the first ever Practitioner training in Ireland. The course was held in a small town called Kinnegad, which is in central Ireland - that is, equally inaccessible for just about everyone! We had twelve students, almost all of whom had already taken an Emm-Tech course, and the feedback was really positive, with a lot of interest in putting together more Emm-Techs and another professional course further south.

In England, we are establishing a base in Birmingham, which is again in the centre of the country. Judith Johnson and Liz James have been running some very successful Emm-Tech courses both in Wales and in the South West of England and so demand is growing for more Practitioner courses there as well. This month, 21 students will take Module 6 of the professional course and the first TBT course is being run in Scotland. Recognition by the therapy associations is growing too: last month we had a short piece published in "The International Therapist", which is the magazine of the Federation of Holistic Therapists – the largest professional therapy organisation in the country. They included a piece on their website, which is available for all their members to view.

Andy Eckley, shortly to take Module 6 of Emmett, is co-ordinating a visit by Steve and Kath Rochford next summer to bring Equine Muscle Management to England: contact him on [andy@andyeckley.co.uk](mailto:andy@andyeckley.co.uk) for further details.
